## **ARTICLE I – MEMBERSHIP**

**Sec. 3** Lifetime membership shall be conferred upon the President of the L.S.C.A. at the completion of the term in office. This carries all privileges of regular membership.

## **ARTICLE III - NOMINATIONS AND ELECTIONS**

**Sec. 1** The approval of the Executive Board shall be held at the January meeting of the association.

**Sec. 2** A nominating committee made up of the present officers for the purpose of selecting a slate of candidates for office for the upcoming year shall meet in December.

**Sec. 3** A slate of candidates for offices and the Executive Board shall be presented for approval to the regular membership at the January meeting. If not approved, at this time nominations may be made from the floor by the regular membership.

**Sec. 4** A vacancy during the year shall be filled by a vote of the Executive Board.

**Sec. 5** The term of office for the officers and the Executive Board shall be two years with the term to begin at the July meeting.

## **ARTICLE IV - DUTIES OF OFFICERS AND EXECUTIVE BOARD**

**Sec. 1** The President shall preside at the semi-annual meetings of the L.S.C.A. and other called meetings of the Association, shall be responsible for gathering and selecting materials and distributing the quarterly newsletter (Sept./Dec./March/June), shall represent the L.S.C.A. at meetings of allied organizations and he/her and the Executive Board shall appoint all committee chairpersons.
